

Eligibility

To be eligible to apply for the Travis Schoenbeck Memorial Scholarship, an applicant must:

- Be a member of or child, grandchild or great grandchild of a current member of American Legion Post 75, Sons of American Legion Squadron 75 or American Legion Auxiliary Unit 75.
- Applicant or sponsor must have been a member for a minimum of 1 year.
- Provide two letters of recommendation from a non-relative such as a community leader, school counselor, teacher, or pastor.
- Provide official transcripts of most recently completed educational courses. – Minimum GPA 3.0.
- Provide a description of your community service activities in the last 12 months.
- Write a short essay, not to exceed 100 words, on how receiving this scholarship will assist you in achieving your future goals. No personal identifying remarks should be in this essay.
- Be enrolled to attend a college, university, technical or trade school full or part time.
- Submit all required materials and completed application by mail only to:

Background Information

Travis William Schoenbeck, born March 4, 1975, was the grandson of Walter Schoenbeck, a deceased member of American Legion Post 75. Travis graduated from Fox High School in St. Louis, Missouri, and his ambition was to earn a college degree in business management. He tragically died as the result of an automobile accident on September 10, 1995. In his memory, American Legion Post 75 established this scholarship for the purpose of assisting individuals associated with Post 75 with their own college education. It has been an honor to provide each successive generation the opportunity to achieve their dreams.

This scholarship will be paid directly to the college, university, technical or trade school where the recipient is enrolled.

The Education Committee reserves the right to verify financial eligibility with your college of choice.

If chosen and you subsequently receive a full scholarship from another source, this award will go to the first alternate.
